


Data Collection: News Articles

- Time period: 1995-2016




Data Collection: Twitter

Time period 2013-2016












Visualizations: Physical Attacks Timeline - Target Groups vs Control Group



Quantitative Analysis



- Xenophobic behaviors don't seem to be dominant in Greece.
 - The increase of violent incidents targeting foreigners should be examined in the light of a rise of aggressiveness in general, irrespectively of national identity of the victim.
 - Financial misery can cause an outbreak of violence.

• Physical and verbal aggression as indicators of xenophobic attitudes in Greece seem to be addressed to the same targets.

Qualitative Analysis



- Specific Stereotypes and Prejudices: confirmed coinciding with literature findings
 - Albanians:
 - *crime*" and *"cultural inferiority*" stereotypes indicating a continuity of the so-called stereotype of the Balkanian criminal
 - ✓ calls for ouster/deportation
 - Jews:
 - ✓ calls for physical extinction are far greater for Jews than for any other group
 - ✓ a perception of a particular enmity towards the Greek nation & blame attribution patterns of the Greek crisis
 - ✓ identification with the negative aspects of the banking system and global capitalism & frequent appeal to conspiracy theory elements
- Two different dimensions of xenophobia:
 - Dominance is directed against Albanians and Pakistani
 - Vulnerability in the case of Jews
